***** NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING*****
LAFCO CASE #1588 (EAST OROSI CSD)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO). The hearing will be held at Administrative Building Supervisors Chambers, County Civic Center, 2800 W. Burrel Avenue, Visalia, on **December 11th, 2024, at 2:00 P.M.**, to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding the following proposal: Annexation of the area encompassed by East Oroshi Community Services District (CSD) into the Oroshi Public Utility District (PUD) for water service, and Divestiture of the power to provide water service from East Oroshi CSD, **LAFCO Case # 1588**.

The County of Tulare submitted an application that was filed with the Executive Officer of the LAFCO. The proposal area is approximately 57.52 acres for water service into the Oroshi PUD. East Oroshi CSD will remain for the provision of only sewer service. The proposal includes divestiture of the power to provide domestic water service from East Oroshi CSD. The communities of Oroshi and East Oroshi are located along California State Route 63 and Avenue 416, approximately 15 miles northeast of the city of Visalia and 7 miles east of the city of Dinuba.

The LAFCO approved the proposal on November 6, 2024. The proposed terms and conditions for this formation are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No.24-021, which is available for review at the **Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission, 210 N. Church Street Suite B, Visalia, CA**. Written protests must comply with Government Code § 57051. Any registered voter residing within and anyone owning land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file a written protest. Such a protest must be submitted to LAFCO prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, LAFCO case number and date.
