NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 29th day of SEPTEMBER, 2011, an application was filed with the Executive Officer of the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission for an extraterritorial service agreement for certain territory to be served by the Richgrove Community Service District in the County of Tulare, and that said Executive Officer has fixed November 2, 2011, at 2:00 P.M., in the Administrative Building, Supervisors Chambers, County Civic Center, 2800 W. Burrel Avenue, Visalia, California, as the date, time and place of the public hearing upon said application.

The environmental impact of the proposed extraterritorial service agreement will be considered at the hearing. A Negative Declaration has been prepared and approved by Richgrove Community Service District for use in this project. Interested persons may inspect or obtain copies of said document at the Tulare County LAFCO, 5955 S. Mooney Blvd., Visalia, California.

The agreement consists of the provision of domestic water to Rodriquez Labor Camp, and five parcels owned by Agri-Cel Inc./Pandol Bros. (APNs 338-040-010,11,12, and 13 and 338-250-005) and the offices of Monarch Nut Co., located at 786 Road 188. Approval of the agreement is required due to the parcels being outside the service area and Sphere of Influence of the provider agency (Richgrove Community Service District).

If you challenge the Commission's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission at or prior to the public hearing.
