

**NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING
BEFORE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE
TULARE COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) Tulare County. The hearing will be held at Tulare County Association of Governments, 210 N. Church, Suite B, Visalia CA, on **Monday October 2, 2017 at 1 p.m.**, to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding the following proposal: LAFCO Case# **1534-V-451 City of Visalia Reorganization,**

Annexation No. 2017-01. The annexation proposal includes about 21.6 acres of land located southeast of K Road and Burke Street including 6 parcels 123-090-008, -009, -011, -012, -013, and 123-100-004 and detachment of the same area from County Service Area 1. Commission proceedings were initiated by resolution of application by the City of Visalia. The Tulare County LAFCO approved the proposal on August 30, 2017. The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No.17-015 which is available for review at the address listed above. Written protests must comply with Government Code §57051. Any person owning land within the territory proposed to be annexed may file a written protest. Such protest must be submitted to the address listed above prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO case number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.
