No person or agency shall make any further request for the same change or a substantially similar change, as determined by the Commission.

If you challenge the actions of Tulare County LAFCO on the review in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Tulare County LAFCO at, or prior to, the hearing.

State law requires this notice to be mailed to all landowners and registered voters owning or residing on land within the affected territory as well as to those landowners and registered voters owning or residing on land located within 300 feet of the proposal.
