WOODLAKE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND DETACHMENT FROM COUNTY
SERVICE AREA #1, CASE 1540-W-24**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application was filed with the Executive Officer of the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission for an annexation of certain territory to the City of Woodlake and Woodlake Fire Protection District in the County of Tulare and detachment from County Service Area (CSA) #1, and that said Executive Officer has fixed **March 6th, 2019 at 2:00 P.M.**, in the Administrative Building, Supervisors Chambers, County Civic Center, 2800 W. Burrel Ave, Visalia, CA, as the date, time and place of the public hearing upon said application.

The proposal area is approximately 49 acres of land located southwest of the corner of West Ropes Avenue and South Oaks Street. The annexation is intended to serve the creation of a storm water retention basin.

Under CEQA Section 15319 Class 19, the proposal is considered exempt from CEQA review. Copies of environmental documentation, detailed boundary information and other information regarding this case may be inspected or obtained at the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission, 210 N Church Suite B, Visalia, CA.

State law requires this notice to be mailed to all landowners and registered voters owning or residing on land within the affected territory as well as to those landowners and registered voters owning or residing on land located within 300 feet of the proposal. To ascertain whether or not your property or residence is included in this proposal, please refer to the map located on the reverse side of this page.

Pursuant to GC §56663(c), unless written opposition is received regarding this annexation the Commission intends to waive protest proceedings. There is a potential for the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment or tax by the local agency in the affected territory.

The Commission may, as a result of the hearing, approve boundaries for the proposed annexation that differ from and/or include more or less territory than that described. If you challenge the Commission's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission at or prior to the public hearing.
