An application was filed with the Executive Officer of the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission for a sphere of influence amendment, annexation, and detachment to the Lindsay Strathmore Irrigation District. Approximately 229 acres of land are proposed for annexation and 310 acres of land for detachment at various locations.
