**** NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING****

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Hearing will be held by the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO). Hearings will be held at the ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING, SUPERVISORS CHAMBERS, COUNTY CIVIC CENTER, 2800 W BURREL AVENUE, VISALIA, on **January 20th, 2021 at 2:00 P.M.**, to hear the following proposals:

- **DISSOLUTION OF THE DUCOR IRRIGATION DISTRICT, FORMATION OF THE DUCOR WATER DISTRICT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SPHERE OF INFLUENCE FOR THE DUCOR WATER DISTRICT, CASE 1551A, 1552B, AND 1553C (DUCOR ID-WD).** An application was filed with the Executive Officer of the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission for a proposal by petition for formation and a resolution of application for the dissolution of the Ducor Irrigation District (ID) and formation of the Ducor Water District. The district covers approximately 10,522 acres of land. Ducor ID has prepared and approved a Notice of Exemption for use in this project.
- **SPHERE OF INFLUENCE AMENDMENT, ANNEXATION AND ACTIVATION OF LATENT CEMETERY MAINTENANCE POWERS TO THE ALLENSWORTH COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AND DETACHMENT FROM THE TULARE PUBLIC CEMETERY DISTRICT, CASE 1552A, 1552B, AND 1552C (ALLENSWORTH CSD).** An application was filed with the Executive Officer of the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission for a Sphere of Influence amendment, annexation and activation of latent cemetery maintenance powers to the Allensworth Community Services District (CSD) and a detachment from the Tulare Public Cemetery District. The annexation proposal area is approximately 5 acres of land located northwest of the intersection of Road 80 and Avenue 28 alignment. Allensworth CSD has prepared and approved a Notice of Exemption for use in this project.
- **SPHERE OF INFLUENCE AMENDMENT, ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF FARMERSVILLE, AND DETACHMENT FROM CSA #1, CASE 1553-F-27A AND 1553-F-27B.** An application was filed with the Executive Officer of the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission for an annexation to the City of Farmersville and detachment from County Service Area #1. The proposal area is for approximately 13.4 acres of land located approximately 220 feet north of Avenue 264 and 2,000 feet east of Road 156 and 2.4 acres of land located along the Visalia Road Right-of-Way. City of Farmersville has prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration for use in this project. As a Responsible Agency the Mitigated Negative Declaration will be considered at the hearing.

Copies of environmental documentation, detailed boundary information and other information regarding these cases may be inspected or obtained at the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission, 210 N Church Suite B, Visalia, CA. Pursuant to GC §56375.3, the Commission intends to waive protest proceedings. If you cannot attend the public hearing described in this notice, you may submit written comments prior to the hearing. The Commission may, as a result of the hearing, approve boundaries for the proposed changes of organization that differ from and/or include more or less territory than that described. If you challenge the Commission's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Tulare County Local Agency Formation Commission at or prior to the public hearing.
